

A Consultative Workshop with a Student Delegation from the Faculty of Medicine, New Giza University (NGU) to raise students' awareness on the values and principles of human rights, particularly health and reproductive rights, and the rights of doctors and patients

February 11, 2024

The workshop concluded with a set of recommendations, including:

- Students review the human rights curriculum taught in accordance with the decision of the Supreme Council of Universities, and submit the necessary proposals to change the way human rights messages are delivered, making the curriculum student-friendly and applicable, with a focus on the principles of equality and non-discrimination.
- The students prepared a detailed action plan proposal, including a work plan with the Council, supported by the Co-funded European Union project at NCHR to raise student awareness of human rights, and build student cadres capable of training in the field of human rights. They also prepared a guide on patient and physician rights, as well as awareness brochures to raise awareness of rights in educational and treatment institutions.
