Carried out by the Training and Capacity Building Committee from January to date

Introduction

Within the framework of the National Council for Human Rights' (NCHR) endeavor to implement and promote the culture of human rights, through the presence of the Training and Capacity Building Committee, which is one of NCHR's important committees, which strives to train and build the capabilities of employees of government agencies (ministries and governorates) and encourage the establishment and development of their human rights units. As well as the role of NCHR in enhancing youth participation, developing their skills, building their capacities, instilling basic principles of rights and duties, and making them aware of national and international human rights issues.

These courses aim to spread the culture of human rights among ministries and human rights units within the governorates, and to raise the technical capabilities of these groups by increasing awareness of the concept of human rights and providing them with the knowledge and skills related to the concept of human rights.

Activities that were implemented:

• The Training and Capacity Building Committee implemented 7 training courses targeting 172 trainees, in light of the new formation of NCHR, for the Ministries of Planning, Economic Development, and Social Solidarity in Cairo and the governorates.

• 4 training courses were held for employees of the General Office of the Ministry of Social Solidarity inside the headquarters of NCHR in the Fifth Settlement,

targeting 100 trainees from undersecretaries, department directors, directors of the Office the Minister, and social workers.

• Holding a training course at the headquarters of the Ministry of Planning and Economic Development targeting 20 trainees - heads and directors of departments in the ministry.

• Implementing two training courses in Alexandria and Beheira governorates for workers in the Social Solidarity Directorates and their affiliated departments, targeting 52 trainees from the directors of the various sections and departments in the Directorate.
